Tile Countertop Maintenance

Regular use of a Neutral PH cleaner is recommended for all stone and tile countertop surfaces. Many times a glass cleaner or dish soap have been recommended by the installer or fabricator of the countertop and this is incorrect. A neutral ph cleaner will give you a safe cleaning with a non toxic cleaner that won't leave harmful residues on the surface. When applying the Neutral PH cleaner let it dwell on the countertop for a few minutes in order for it to work. Just spraying on and wiping right off does not allow the cleaner time to do its work. Also be sure to rinse the countertop with clean water in order to remove any dirt and cleaner residues from the surface of the tile, grout, or stone.

Clean spills as soon as possible on countertop, do not leave wine, food, liquids on the surface as these will eventually be able to penetrate through the sealer and possibly cause a permanent stain in the countertop.

Do not use a scouring pad on the surface of your countertop. Some of these pads are aggressive and can cause issues with grout and natural stone, ruining the finish.
